WHEREAS, on August 2nd, 2013, the Town transmitted to the Property Appraiser its "Proposed Millage Rate" for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2013 and further scheduled the public hearing required by Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes to be held on September 18, 2013 at 7:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Property Appraiser has properly noticed the public hearing scheduled for September 18, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at One Golden Beach Drive, Golden Beach, Florida, as required by Chapter 200 of the Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing, as required by Section 200.065(2)(c), was held by the Town Council on September 18, 2013, commencing at 7:00 p.m., as previously noticed and the public and all interested parties having had the opportunity to address their comments to the Town Council and the Town Council having considered the comments of the public regarding the proposed millage rate and having complied with the "TRIM" requirements of the Florida Statutes, the Town Council approved a proposed millage rate of 7.1130 mills; and

WHEREAS, as required by Section 200.065(2)(c) a second public hearing was held by the Town Council on September 25, 2013, commencing at 7:00 p.m., as previously noticed, and the public and all interested parties had the opportunity to address their comments to the Town Council and the Town Council considered the comments of the public regarding the final millage rate and complied with the "TRIM" requirements of the Florida Statutes.
