A Message from the Town Manager

We would like to thank our Residents for their understanding as the Town continues to clean up after Hurricane Irma. Town staff has been present in Town before, during and after the storm whipped through our neighborhoods, and we will continue to work until we get Golden Beach back to its prestorm self. We have heard your concerns and frustrations and please know we are working diligently to make everyone comfortable and happy.

We are here to help in whatever ways possible. Please let us know if you need any sort of assistance.

Internet, Phones, Cable: Many services have been restored Town-wide. If you are still without service please contact or visit Town Hall; we are in constant communication with the utility companies and will keep working with them until utilities are completely restored.

Storm Debris:

- Please note that it is the Residents' responsibility to clean their yards.
- The Public Works Department will collect any debris that is brought curbside. All debris should be left 2 feet away from curb to prevent obstructing the streets.
- Tree limbs do not need to be chopped into smaller sizes, the crews will collect items as-is.
- Waste must be separated; garbage must be bagged and placed in the blue bins provided by the Town, trash must be gathered in one pile, and landscaping debris must be gathered in a separate pile. Remember: "Garbage" refers to regular household waste from kitchen/bathroom waste paper baskets. "Trash" refers to furniture and bulkier items. "Landscaping Debris" is plant-based lawn waste.
- Garbage collection will take place today and again on Monday. All garbage must be properly bagged.
- Trash will be collected on a rolling basis until all trash has been collected, so you may place items curbside as they are ready and crews will come by and collect them.
- Landscaping debris will also be collected on a rolling basis.

Town Hall: Services at Town Hall, including building permitting, will resume normal services starting Monday morning. Town Staff has been working since the storm on the Town's Hurricane-related recovery, but will return to their regular posts as of Monday.
