



**SUPPLEMENT TO DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY  
(ORDER NO. 2)  
REQUIRING INDIVIDUALS TO USE A FORM OF COVERING OVER NOSE AND MOUTH**

**WHEREAS**, the detailed findings of Governor Ron Desantis's Orders No. 20-52, No. 20-68, No. 20-82, 20-83, 20-91, and 20-92 are hereby incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the detailed findings of Miami-Dade County Mayor Gimenez as contained in Emergency Order 07-20, dated March 19, 2020 is hereby adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:**

1. **Effective at noon, April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020** all persons who are outside for any reason such as walking, exercising, etc. – it is strongly recommended to wear a face covering over the nose and mouth. Although it is not required so long as social distancing is maintained in accordance with CDC guidelines, if police see that a face covering is not being worn and social distancing is not being maintained, the use of the face covering will be enforced.
2. All persons going to a grocery store, doctor's office, pharmacy, or other essential services establishment is required to wear a cloth facial covering.
3. A covering over the nose and mouth may include a face mask, homemade mask, or other cloth covering, such as a scarf, bandana, handkerchief or other similar cloth covering.

**Exceptions.**

Nothing herein shall require the wearing of face coverings by the following persons:

1. Persons under the age of two years
2. Persons for whom a face covering would cause impairment due to an existing health condition
3. While on your own property, such as collecting mail or performing yard work
4. While in your personal vehicle or boat
5. While working with no face-to-face interactions with public
6. While working where use of a face mask will not be compatible with job duties

**Effective Date.**

This Emergency Executive Order shall become effective on April 10, 2020, at 12:00 p.m.
