

RESOLUTION NO. 591-90

RESOLUTION OF TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO PURCHASE TWO NEW POLICE CARS PURSUANT TO BIDS RECEIVED BY DADE COUNTY AS PER CO-OPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the police vehicles Units 121, 123, 1988 Plymouths are in fair condition and are no longer economically servicable, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council allocated funds for the replacement of said vehicles as per the FY 1989-90 Budget, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL, TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Town Council approve purchasing the cars as per Dade County Bid No. 1672 OEC-CW.

Section 2. The Town Council approves authorization of the following purchase:

Two (2) 1990 Ford Crown Victoria in the amount of \$12,470 per unit for a total of \$24,940.


