Data was collected from November 29, 2017 through January 31, 2018 through a physical survey mailed to Residents homes that was supplied with return postage and also through a digital survey hosted by Constantcontact.com, which was emailed to Residents who had supplied their email information to be used as a method of receiving Town news and notifications. The digital survey was also announced in the Town Magazine and a link to the survey was included on the Town website. All results were collected and tabulated by the Town's Residents Services Department.
