## MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE

TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA

April 6th, 1948

A Special Meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida, was held on April 6, 1948, at 3:00 o'clock P. M. at the Town Hall, pursuant to a notice of Special Meeting dated March 23, 1948, the original copy of which notice is attached to these minutes and made a part hereof.

Upon roll call the following members were found to be present, constituting all of the members of the Town Council:

Mayor Councilmen Mr. James T. Hennegan Mr. George H. Draper, Jr.

Mr. G. A. Mavon

Mr. R. H. George Mr. William A. Mentzer Mr. Martin L. Pulcher

There was also present:

Attorney - Mr. Francis M. Miller

Fred G. Gamer, Deputy Town Clerk, was absent, due to illness.

Mr. Martin L. Pulcher, President of the Town Council acted as Chairman of the meeting and Francis M. Miller as Secretary thereof in the absence of the Deputy Town Clerk.

The notice of the Special Meeting of the Town Council was read and the Council immediately considered the matters and things set forth in the Notice. Thereupon, upon motion duly made by Councilman R. H. George and seconded by Councilman G. A. Mavon, and upon a roll call vote, the following Resolution was unanimously adopted:

"WHEREAS, the present building used for a Town Hall is entirely inadequate for its purpose and was formerly the town dock, and

WHEREAS, the town equipment, trucks, power mowers and tools are inadequately stored and are suffering great damage because of improper storage facilities and it would be

economy for the Town to provide adequate storage facilities, a place of meeting for the Town Council and citizens and a proper place to house the Town Police and Town Superintendent, and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that a Town Hall could be erected on Lots F & G now owned by the Town for a sum of money not to exceed \$25,000.00,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

That there is hereby ordered a municipal improvement, to be erected on Lots F & G, Golden Beach, owned by the Town, consisting of a Town Hall, garage and storage facilities and quarters for the Town Police and sleeping accommodations for the Town Superintendent,

FURTHER RESOLVED: That it is estimated the cost of said improvement will not exceed the sum of \$25,000.00,

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Mayor, Director of Finance and Director of Parks and Public Buildings be and they are hereby appointed a committee to carry out the provisions of this Resolution and to let any contract or contracts to that end, subject to the approval by the qualified electors of the Town authorizing the issuance of bonds of the Town for the cost of said improvement.

PASSED and ADOPTED by the unanimous vote of the Town Council this 6th day of April, A. D. 1948".

The original of said Resolution was then signed by the Mayor in order to be signed by the Deputy Clerk.

The matter of issuing bonds for the payment of the cost of the improvements voted by the Resolution just passed was then discussed and thereupon, upon motion made by Councilman R. H. George and seconded by Councilman William A. Mentzer and upon a roll call vote, the following Resolution was unanimously adopted:

COUNTRIES, the Town Council has this day passed a Resolution ordering a municipal deprevent to the Town consisting of a Town Building on lots F & G, Golden Beach, the estimated cost of said improvement, including incidental expenses is not in excess of \$25,000.00, and

WHENEYAS, it is necessary to call an election for the purpose of issuing bonds for the cost of said improvement and there is no newspaper published in the Town,

MON PRESENCE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

That em effection is hereby called for the little day of May, 1948, to be held in the Town of Colden Beach at which election a carjority of the freeholders who are qualified effectors shall determine whether or most they are in favor of the issuance of bounds of the Town of Golden Beach in the cost of a municipal building to be erected the Town of Golden Beach,

That there is hereby ordered published, for at least thirty days,
south of said election by publication
of such hotice in the Miami Herald, a newsprocess of general circulation in Dade County,
line ide, once each week for four consecuit we weeks during said period of thirty days.

ADO PTED by the unanimous vote of lower Council this 6th day of April,
