were not able to be present at this Meeting. The meeting was called to order by the President, Mr. N. B. Ornitz, who acted as Chairman of this Meeting and Mrs. Laurita Chapman acted as Secretary.

The President, Mr. N. B. Ornitz stated that the purpose of this Special Meeting was to discuss further the taking over of our traffic cases by the Metropolitan Court of Dade County.

The President, Mr. N. B. Ornitz reported that today a restraining order had been issued by Judge Pat Cannon of the Circuit Court of Dade County prohibiting certain cities in Dade County from issuing their own summons for traffic violations and since Golden Beach comes under this jurisdiction he would like to present the following Resolution which upon motion duly made seconded and unanimously carried was passed and adopted.

MRESOLUTION

WHEREAS, at a Special Meeting of the Town Council of the Town Of Golden Beach, Florida, held on June 27th, 1959, the following Resolution was unanimously adopted:

WBE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town Of Golden Beach, Florida, that the functions of the Municipal Court of the Town Of Golden Beach, be retained as presently constituted until notice is received from Competent, Legal or Government Authority to change or amend such functions, at which time further action will be determined by the

WHEREAS on July 20th, 1959, Circuit Judge, the Honorable Pat Cannon issued a restraining order prohibiting the Cities of Miami Beach, Miami Springs and El Portal from issuing traffic summons for moving violations other than in the form prescribed by the Metro Commission for Uniform Traffic Violations

Council of the Town Of Golden Beach recognizes such the Resolution hereinabove cited as "Competent, Legal Authority to change or amend such functions" of the Municipal Court of the Town Of Golden Beach,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Town Council of the Town Of Golden Beach, Florida, that the Police Commissioner of the Municipality be and he hereby is instructed to notify the Police Department, effective immediately, to issue traffic summonses for moving violations within their jurisdiction on the form provided by the Metro Commission, being the "Metropolitan Dade County Uniform Traffic Complaint and Ticket" and be it further

RESOLVED, that such Resolution remain in full force and effect until a final determination by legal authority as to the rights and privileges of Municipalities as to all matters being litigated.
