

**GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA
ORDINANCE NO. 425,97**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 235 (ADOPTED JUNE 15, 1982) REGARDING THE COMMUNITY ANTENNA TELEVISION (CATV) FRANCHISE; EXTENDING THE EXISTING FRANCHISE FOR APPROXIMATELY THREE MONTHS (TILL SEPTEMBER 30, 1997) FOR FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND REVIEW; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach had granted a CATV franchise to Gold Coast Cablevision pursuant to Ordinance No. 235 (adopted June 15, 1982) and;

WHEREAS, the franchise expires on June 15, 1997 and;

WHEREAS, the Town desires to extend the franchise for approximately three months to take the opportunity to review the franchise and consider Gold Coast Cablevision's request for renewal of the franchise;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the CATV franchise granted to Gold Coast Cablevision by the Town of Golden Beach is hereby extended to September 30, 1997. The terms and conditions of that ordinance, as may have been amended from time to time which are not inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby ratified.

Section 2. Conflict That all ordinances or parts of ordinances, all Town Code sections or parts of Town Code sections, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. Severability That the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption on second reading.

The Motion to adopt the foregoing Ordinance on first reading was offered by Councilwoman Lowrance, seconded by Councilwoman Addicott and on roll call the following vote ensued:


