

RESOLUTION 413-88

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL, TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH
UNDER THE FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT GRANTS
TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Town of Golden Beach is interested in carrying out the following described project for the enjoyment of the citizenry of Golden Beach, Dade County and the State of Florida:

Project Title: Golden Beach Marine Patrol/Boat Safety Project

Total Estimated Cost \$ 117,000

Brief Description of Project:

Establish a Marine Patrol division to patrol canals of Golden Beach and approximately 1.5 miles of the Intracoastal Waterway bordering unincorporated Dade County areas of Turnberry/Aventura and Waterways Developments,

AND, Florida Inland Navigation financial assistance is required for program mentioned above,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach that the project described above be authorized,

AND, be it further resolved that said Town Manager make application to the Florida Inland Navigation District in the amount of 50% of the actual cost of the project in behalf of said Town of Golden Beach

AND, be it further resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach that it certifies to the following:

1. That it will accept the terms and conditions set forth in the FIND Grants Guidelines and which will be a part of the Project Agreement for any grant awarded under the attached proposal.
2. That it is in complete accord with the attached proposal and that it will carry out the Program in the manner described in the proposal and any plans and specifications attached thereto unless prior approval for any change has been received from the District.
3. That it has the ability and intention to finance its share of the cost of the project and that the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of said Town of Golden Beach for public benefit.
4. That it will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to this proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P.L. 88-352 (1964) and design and construct all facilities to comply fully with statutes relating to accessibility by handicapped persons as well as other federal, state and local laws, rules and requirements.
5. That it will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for reimbursement.

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6. That it will make available to FIND, a post-audit of expenses incurred on the project prior to, or in conjunction with, request for the final 10% of the funding agreed to by FIND.






