

RESOLUTION NO. 429-88

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL, TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND TOWN OFFICIALS TO NOTIFY THE APPROPRIATE FEDERAL, STATE, AND COUNTY AGENCIES RE-STATING OFFICIAL CONCERN AND REQUEST ESTABLISHING BOATING SAFETY MEASURES ALONG THE INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach has experienced property damage to seawalls, boats and docks, and,

WHEREAS, there are no minimum speed/no wake signs currently posted along the Intracoastal Waterway in Golden Beach, and,

WHEREAS, there is limited patrol and minimum enforcement, and,

WHEREAS, this hazardous condition is a threat to the safety and welfare of all boaters and residents in the area, and,

WHEREAS, this hazardous condition is a threat to area vegetation and marine animal life.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach authorizes its Mayor and proper Town Officials to notify the appropriate regulatory agencies to survey the problem, post signs and provide aggressive enforcement and continuous patrol of this area.

Section 2. That the Town Council requests that a "No Wake" zone be created in this area.
