

RESOLUTION OF INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA SUPPORTING CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 4 (ARTICLE 7, SECTION 17) "BONDS FOR ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY FOR STATE ROADS OR CONSTRUCTING BRIDGES" AND URGING THE CITIZENS OF GOLDEN BEACH TO FAVORABLY CONSIDER THEIR APPROVAL OF SAME.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida has reviewed proposed Constitutional Amendment No. 4 that allows the State of Florida to bond general revenues for road right-of-way acquisition and construction of bridges, and

WHEREAS, the individual Members of the Town Council concur that the approval of this Constitutional Amendment will allow the Legislature more flexibility and cost savings in financing for road acquisition and bridge projects, and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida urban areas such as Dade County, Florida, expect to benefit from road improvements,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. That individual Members of the Town Council of Golden Beach support the approval of Constitutional Amendment No. 4 to be voted on in the November 1988 election.

Section 2. That the individual Members of the Town Council of Golden Beach in approving this resolution urge the citizens of Golden Beach to also consider approval of Amendment No. 4, on the November 1988 Ballot.
