

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF THE LAW FIRM OF MULLER, MINTZ, KORNREICH, CALDWELL, CASEY, CROSLAND & BRAMNICK TO REPRESENT THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH IN LABOR UNION ELECTION AND OTHER EMPLOYEE LABOR ORGANIZATION MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the Dade County Police Benevolent Association, Inc. have petitioned the Town of Golden Beach for recognition as the collective bargaining representatives for the Police Officers and Sergeants, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach considers it in the best interest of the Town to retain special labor counsel to represent the Town in these proceedings, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council have reviewed the resume of Muller, Mintz, Kornreich, Caldwell, Casey, Crosland and Bramnick and are satisfied that they have the necessary experience and qualifications to properly represent the Town in this matter.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. That the Town Council approves the appointment of Muller, Mintz, Kornreich, Caldwell, Casey, Crosland and Bramnick as Labor Counsel to represent the Town.

Section 2. That the representation fee schedule of \$100.00 per hour plus reimbursement for actual out of pocket costs be approved.
