

RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPROVAL OF DADE COUNTY WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITY DEPARTMENT'S RECOMMENDATION THAT THE DADE COUNTY COMMISSION AWARD THE CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM TO THE LOW BIDDER, FLORIDA ROADS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,684,402.90.

WHEREAS, the Dade County Water and Sewer Authority Department publicly solicited formal sealed bids for the construction of the proposed Sanitary Sewer Project in Golden Beach, and

WHEREAS, Florida Roads Construction Company submitted the low bid in the amount of \$2,684,402.90, and

WHEREAS, the Dade County Water and Sewer Authority Department and Town Engineer, Richard Grant reviewed said bids and recommended that the Dade County Commission approve the award of the contract to the low bidder,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. The Town Council, Town of Golden Beach concurs with the recommendation of WASA and the Town Engineer to award the Sanitary Sewer Construction Contract to the low bidder.

Section 2. That the Town Council, Town of Golden Beach approves of the Dade County Commission's award to the contract to Florida Roads Construction Company in the amount of \$2,684,402.90.
