- 3. All the wooden refuse is to be cleaned out from under the house and is to remain clean.
- 4. All the loose blocks on the west wall are to be removed and replaced and that the entire wall is to be leveled with the dentel beam.

You are also requested to keep a careful watch at all times on the construction of this building so that no violations to the Town's Building Code occur, until such construction work is completed and that reference should be made to Ordinances No 24 and 52 as to the requirements of the Town's building code.
