

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA

June 25th, 1960

A Special Meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida was held on Saturday, June 25th, 1960 at 10:00 o'clock in the morning at the home of Councilman Mr. F. Waldo Roth, 484 North Bay Drive, Golden Beach, Florida. Upon roll call the following members were found to be present constituting all the Members of the Council.

The meeting was called to order by the Council President, Mr. N. B. Ornitz who acted as Chairman of this meeting and who stated that the purpose of this meeting was to discuss having an addition added to the present Town garage.

The Council President, Mr. N. B. Ornitz, called upon the Mayor and Town Manager, Mr. Larry O. Turner, who reported that although the Council at a Special Meeting held on Saturday, May 28th, 1960, had decided to eliminate the work of having an addition made to the present Town garage when the improvements are made to the Town Hall, a further study had been made as to what space would be available for the storage of Town equipment. Since part of the garage attached to the Town Hall, which has been used for housing Town equipment is to be converted into office space, additional room will be needed for storage purposes, therefore he ask the Members of the Council to consider rescinding their former decision to eliminate the work of having an addition made to the present garage and give their approval to have this work done as it was his opinion that sufficient funds would be available in the Improvement Bond Fund to cover the cost of this work. Considerable discussion followed on this matter, afterwhich it was agreed upon motion by Councilman Mr. F. Waldo Roth, seconded by Councilman Mr. Edward M. Stuart and upon a voiced vote by roll call unanimously carried that the addition to the present Town garage be made in accordance with the plans originally submitted for this work, providing that the cost will not exceed the amount provided for same in the Improvement Bond Issue.

There being no further business to come before the Members of the Council at this meeting, upon motion by Councilman Mr. Joseph R. Missett, seconded by Councilman Mr. F. Waldo Roth, the meeting adjourned.
