

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF

December 30th, 1959

A Special Meeting of the Town Council of the Town Of Golden Beach, Florida, was held on Wednesday, December 30th, 1959 at 9:30 o'clock in the morning at the Town Hall. Upon roll call the following members were found to be present constituting all the Members of the Council.

The Meeting was called to order by the Council President, Mr. N. B. Ornitz, who acted as Chairman of this Meeting and Mrs. Laurita Chapman acted as Secretary.

The President, Mr. N. B. Ornitz, stated that the purpose of this Special Meeting was to canvass the ballots of the Special Bond Election held on Tuesday, December 29th, 1959 at the Town Hall.

The President, Mr. N. B. Ornitz, called upon the Secretary who unlocked the ballot box and the Certificate of the Inspectors and Clerk of this Special Bond Election was removed from the ballot box and read by the Council President, Mr. N. B. Ornitz and upon examination of same by the Members of the Council, a motion was duly made, seconded and unanimously carried that the Certificate of of the Inspectors and Clerk of this Special Bond Election be accepted.

Dear Resident:

We wish to advise you that the results of the Special Bond Election held at the Town Hall on Tuesday, December 29th, 1959, are as follows:

That For Bonds for the cost of bridges in the amount of \$45,000, a total of 147 votes were cast of which 121 votes were FOR and 26 votes were AGAINST this issue, thus the issuance of bonds for this purpose was carried,

That For Bonds for the purpose of remodeling the Town Hall in the amount of \$30,000, a total of 136 votes were cast, of which 82 votes were FOR and 54 votes were AGAINST this issue, thus the issuance of bonds for this purpose was carried.

That For Bonds for Improving Ocean Boulevard in the amount of \$10,000, a total of 177 votes were cast, of which 92 votes were FOR and 85 votes were AGAINST this issue, thus the issuance of bonds for this purpose was carried.

That For Bonds for Improving the Lighting and Drainage System in the amount of \$5,000, a total of 137 votes were cast of which 109 votes were FOR and 28 votes were AGAINST this issue, thus the issuance of bonds for this purpose was carried.

We wish to thank all those who participated in this election, particularly the ladies who worked so ardently on the election board.
