A motion was made by Council Bennett E. Paulsen and seconded by Councilman George H. Draper, Jr., to secure the services of Mrs. Chapman. This motion was unanimously carried and the Town Clerk was instructed to contact Mrs. Laurita Chapman and have her report for work immediately, thus dispensing with the services of Mr. Paul S.
