

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA

February 7, 1951

A Special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach was held this day in the Town Hall at eleven o'clock A. M.
