

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA

January 21, 1950

A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach was held at the Town Hall at the call of the Mayor, Dr. Willard Van Camp at 7 p.m. January 21, 1950.

Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

The meeting was called to order by the President of the Town Council; Mr. R. H. George, and Councilman George H. Draper, Jr. acted as Secretary of the meeting.

The Mayor, Dr. Willard Van Camp, stated that the purpose of the meeting was to tender his resignation, but that after receiving several calls from residents of the Town of Golden Beach asking him to continue his full term, together with requests from other members of the Council, he had reconsidered and would continue; whereupon, President of the Town Council, Mr. R. H. George, handed the Secretary a letter which was a written resignation to become effective at once.

On motion of Councilman G. A. Mayon and seconded by Councilman Bennett R. Paulsen, the resignation of the President of the Town Council, Mr. R. H. George, was tabled until the next regular meeting, February 21, 1950. Expressions of regret were expressed by the entire Council, and it was hoped that Mr. George would reconsider before the February meeting.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
