

The meeting was called to order by Mr. W. L. Gilmore, President of the Town Council, who requested the Deputy Town Clerk to read the minutes of the previous meeting held on March 21, 1944. Upon the reading of these minutes, on motion of Mr. Martin Pulcher, seconded by Mr. George H. Draper, Jr., the minutes were unanimously approved.


The President of the Council thereupon requested the Deputy Town Clerk to present his Cash Report and after the reading of this Report showing that cash on hand and in bank as of February 29, 1944 was in the amount of \$14,979.05, Mr. Martin Pulcher moved, which motion was seconded by Mr. George H. Draper, Jr., that the Deputy Town Clerk's Cash Report as of February 29, 1944 be approved and attached to these minutes and made a part hereof.

The Mayor, Mr. Richard K. Lackey, thereupon made his report to the Council, reporting that three of the lights around the Loggia are without globes; that the power company at the present time cannot furnish globes for these light standards. The Mayor further suggested that the record of the police fines be incorporated into the weekly expense reports, and the Deputy Town Clerk advised the Mayor that new expense reports are now ready for the printer and that such a record would be incorporated therein.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion made by Mr. Martin Pulcher, seconded by Mr. Ward A. Scranton, the meeting adjourned.
