ORDINANCE NO. 374-90

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EXCISE TAX FROM 1.00% TO 0.85% ON THE GROSS AMOUNT OF RECEIPTS OF ALL PREMIUMS FROM CASUALTY INSURANCE POLICIES INSURING PROPERTY WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH; AND PROVIDING WHEN SAID TAX SHALL BE DUE AND PAYABLE.

Florida, 1953, created a Special fund known as the "Municipal Police Officers' Retirement an additional tax upon such insurance carriers designated in said act, the said proceeds from Trust Fund" and thereby authorized municipalities falling within the purview of said act, to levy said tax to be used in partial support of said fund, and WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Florida, by Chapter 28230, Laws of

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Golden Beach adopted Ordinance No. 129,

effective May 17, 1973, to levy such tax, and

WHEREAS, the 1988 Florida Legislature reduced the tax rate from 1.00% to

0.85%, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Town of Golden Beach to change the tax rate

in accordance with the actions of the Legislature.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GOLDEN

BEACH:

Section 1. Effective July 1, 1988, the excise tax rate levied by Ordinance

No. 129 shall be changed from 1.00% to 0.85%

Section 2. That the license or excise tax herein levied shall continue to be

due and payable annually on the first day of March of each year hereafter.
