

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE METHOD FOR RESOLVING CONFLICTS BETWEEN A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT AND THE TOWN CHARTER AND BETWEEN SUCH AGREEMENT AND EXISTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 16, 1990, the Town Council passed a resolution ratifying the collective bargaining agreement between the Town of Golden Beach, Florida and the Dade County Police Benevolent Association; and

WHEREAS, certain provisions of the collective bargaining agreement may be in conflict with the Town Charter and/or with existing Town ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That any conflict(s) between the collective bargaining agreement between the Town of Golden Beach and the Dade County Police Benevolent Association shall be resolved in favor of the provisions of the collective bargaining agreement.

Section 2. Repealer. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances, all Charter provisions or parts of Charter provisions, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. Severability. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall be effective on October 16, 1990, the date upon which the Town Council ratified the collective bargaining agreement.
