

ORDINANCE NO. 384-91

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13.04(A) ADOPTION OF BUILDING, PLUMBING, ELECTRICAL AND RELATED TECHNICAL CODES; ADOPTION OF FLORIDA STATUTE CHAPTER 553, PART V, ACCESSIBILITY BY PHYSICALLY HANDICAP PERSONS; ADOPTION OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY CODE FOR BUILDING CONSTRUCTION, 1991 EDITION; ADOPTION OF 1990 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Florida has delegated authority to the Board of Building Codes and Standards to adopt Building Codes by Legislative Rule, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Building Codes and Standards has adopted various Building Codes for approval for use in Florida including the South Florida Building Code (Dade County) which heretofore been adopted by the Town of Golden Beach, and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Model Building Codes aforementioned the Town of Golden Beach is required to enforce Chapter 553, Part V of the Florida Statute relating to Accessibility by Disabled Persons, the Energy Efficiency Code for building construction, 1991 Edition and the 1990 Edition of the National Electrical Code,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH.

(b) The Energy Efficiency Code for Building Construction, 1991 Edition, Developed by the Department of Community Affairs.

(c) The 1990 Edition of the National Electrical Code.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3: That ordinance shall take effect in the manner provided by law.
