

ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, TO REGULATE AND RESTRICT THE PLACING OF ADVERTISING SIGNS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Whenever it is desired to tack, place, construct or exhibit any advertising sign of any kind or description on any property within the limits of the Town of Golden Beach (except on the property owned by the individual person or corporation), such person, firm or corporation shall first make application as hereinafter provided, to the Town Clerk for a permit to tack, place, display or use the same.

Sec. 2. Said application shall be in writing and signed by the applicant, and shall state the plan, design and size of the proposed sign or signs, and said application shall contain a definite and detailed description of the same, and also a definite description of the proposed manner of placing said sign or signs, and the use or uses to which the same are to be put. Said application shall also contain an accurate description of the premises upon which said sign or signs will be placed and used, and the name and address of the owner or person making said application.

Sec. 3. Upon application made in due compliance with this ordinance, the Town Council shall, if they think proper, grant a permit to the applicant to place and use said sign as herein provided, upon payment to the Town of Golden Beach of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each sign so placed, provided, however, that when in the opinion of the Town Council any sign or signs or any proposed sign or signs used or to be used under and by virtue of this ordinance, shall detract from the beauty of the street or property where the same is proposed to be placed, or shall become offensive to the moral or aesthetic senses of the general public, or shall inconvenience the general public, or endanger life or property, the said Town Council may in its discretion refuse the permit herein provided for.

Sec. 4. Any person or persons, firm or corporation guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding twenty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the Municipal Judge.

Sec. 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need, for the preservation of the peace and safety and property of the Town of Golden Beach, and shall become effective immediately after its passage and approval, and posting in three public places as provided by law.
