

ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA,
CREATING A FIREPROOF DISTRICT OR FIRE ZONE IN THE TOWN
OF GOLDEN BEACH, PROVIDING THE TYPE OF BUILDING CON-
STRUCTION WHICH MAY BE PERMITTED TO BE ERECTED, RECON-
STRUCTED OR USED WITHIN SAID DISTRICT AND TO PRESCRIBE
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
ORDINANCE AND ALSO PROVIDE FOR ITS ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN
BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. To secure safety from fire, panic and other
dangers, Blocks A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, J, K, L, M and Blocks 1,
2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 within the limits of the Town of Golden Beach,
be and the same are hereby declared to be a fireproof district or
fireproof zone.

Sec. 2. There shall be no wood, frame, nor non-fireproof
building, structure, shed, tent, nor booth of any kind erected, nor
any addition made to any structure already erected within the fire-
proof district or fireproof zone of the Town of Golden Beach, unless
such building, structure, shed, tent or booth shall be built of brick,
tile, poured concrete, concrete block, stone or other fireproof or
fire resisting material, and no structures may be added to or built
within said district out of frame or lumber or other inflammable
material.

Sec. 3. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to
permit the erection of any buildings in violation of any of the
ordinances of the Town of Golden Beach, and this ordinance shall be
and is hereby declared to be cumulative of all other ordinances of
the Town of Golden Beach, Florida, affecting the subject matter herein.

Sec. 4. The Town Clerk of the Town of Golden Beach be and
she is hereby forbidden to issue any permit for the erection, alter-
ation or repair of any building within the limits of the Town of
Golden Beach which may violate any of the provisions of this ordin-
ance.

Sec. 5. Any person or persons, firm or corporation guilty
of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon con-
viction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding Two Hundred (\$200.00)
Dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding twenty (20) days, or by both
such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Municipal Judge.

Sec. 6. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure
on the ground of urgent public need for the preservation of the safety
and property of the Town of Golden Beach, and shall become effective
immediately after its passage and approval, and posting in three public
places as provided by law.
