

ORDINANCE # 18.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA,
NAMING INSPECTORS AND CLERK FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION
TO BE HELD ON THE THIRD TUESDAY OF FEBRUARY, 1937.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA,

Section 1. That the following qualified voters of the
Town of Golden Beach, Florida, be and they hereby are named in-
spectors of the general election to be held in said Town on the
third Tuesday of February, A. D. 1937, to-wit:

Mrs. Blanche Bancroft, Inspector

Mrs. Almeda VanderWaal, Inspector

Mrs. Daisy Hubbard, Inspector

Section 2. It is further ordained that Mrs. Nora
Helen Tilney, a qualified voter of the Town of Golden Beach,
be and she hereby is named Clerk of the general election to be
held in said Town on the third Tuesday of February, 1937.

Section 3. That said inspectors and Clerk shall have
all the powers provided for in Section 5 of Ordinance #3 of the
Town of Golden Beach, and shall hold the election provided for in
Ordinance #3 in accordance with the provisions of said ordinance.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect im-
mediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
