Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, or failing, neglecting or refusing to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance, or in any manner interfering with, hindering or preventing any officer or person herein mentioned, in the performance of any duty required by the provisions of this ordinance, or any person other than the owner or keeper of such dog, who shall remove or take off or cause to be taken off or removed the collar or the tag or the muzzle upon any dog within the town, shall, upon conviction in the municipal court, be liable to a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, or to imprisonment in the town jail not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment, for each and every offense, at the discretion of the municipal judge.
