

ORDINANCE NO. 22.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID TOWN AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. No dog, male or female, shall be allowed to run at large on the streets, thoroughfares or other public places of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida.

Section 2. When the police shall impound a dog found to be violating Section 1 of this Ordinance, they shall, after complaint by them made, arrest or summon the owner to appear in the municipal court to answer the charge of breach of the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or failing, neglecting or refusing to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or in any manner interfering with, hindering or preventing any officer or person herein mentioned, in the performance of any duty required by the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction in the municipal court, be liable to a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, or to imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment, for each and every offense, at the discretion of the municipal judge.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the protection and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Golden Beach, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Town Council.
