

ORDINANCE NO. 26

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION, PHOTOGRAPHING AND FINGER-PRINTING OF ALL PERSONS EMPLOYED IN SAID TOWN, INCLUDING POLICE, SPECIAL POLICE, TOWN EMPLOYEES AND ALL DOMESTIC SERVANTS EMPLOYED WITHIN THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. From and after the passage of this Ordinance, every person employed within the limits of the Town of Golden Beach, including police, special police, town employees and all domestic servants employed within the Town of Golden Beach, be and they are hereby required to register within forty-eight hours from the time of their employment, or after the passage of this Ordinance, in a book of registration to be kept by the Chief of Police of Golden Beach, and also to be finger-printed and photographed.

Sec. 2. The Chief of Police or Town Marshal, with the assistance of the Mayor, shall cause to be issued to each person so registering a registration or identification card, which said registration or identification card shall be renewed by the holder thereof each twenty-four months thereafter by re-registration, as above set forth.

Sec. 3. For the purpose of defraying the expenses of enforcing this Ordinance, the sum of \$.25 shall be paid for each such registration or identification card, or renewal thereof.

Sec. 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished, upon conviction thereof, by a fine not exceeding \$50.00, or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days, or both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Municipal Judge of the Town of Golden Beach.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
