

ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, REGULATING THE HEIGHT OF BOAT HOUSES IN THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. No boat house shall be built, constructed or erected within the limits of the Town of Golden Beach which shall be higher than twelve feet above mean low tide. Said height shall be measured from the pitch or top of the roof of said boat house to mean low tide.

Sec. 2. It is the purpose and intent of this Ordinance to regulate the height of boat houses within the limits of the Town of Golden Beach so that the inhabitants of the Town may have more light and air and for the prevention of congestion of buildings within the Town.


