

ORDINANCE NO. 37

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PRESERVATION AND PROTECTION OF THE PROPERTY OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, LIMITING THE USE OF THE LOGGIA AND THE OCEAN FRONT AND PROPERTY IMMEDIATELY SURROUNDING THE LOGGIA TO THE USE ONLY BY THE RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH AND DECLARING THIS ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1 adopted the 19th day of October, A. D. 1929, the entire property within the limits of the Town of Golden Beach was designated and established as a restricted residential district, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach owns the property at the foot of the street known as The Strand, said property being commonly known as the Loggia, and surrounding property, and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid property has been reserved for the use of the residents of the Town of Golden Beach and those guests of said residents who may be living within the Town, and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Town Council that the privilege of using said property is being abused, that the Loggia building is being damaged and the cost of cleaning and clearing the beach property has become a burden to the Town by reason of the use of the same by unauthorized persons,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the property known as the Loggia, running from Ocean Boulevard to the ocean on that street within the limits of the Town of Golden Beach called The Strand, be and the same is hereby restricted to the use only by the residents living within the Town of Golden Beach and their immediate house guests who shall be accompanied by said residents to enjoy the privilege of bathing on the beach and the use of said property.

Sec. 2. Any person or persons other than a resident of the Town of Golden Beach and their immediate house guests who may use the property described in Section 1 of this Ordinance, be and they are hereby declared to be trespassers and shall be immediately ejected from said premises by the Town Police.

Sec. 3. There is hereby ordered to be placed on said premises a sign or signs reading substantially as follows:

"RESTRICTED AREA - NO TRESPASSING - POLICE ORDER"
