## ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUILDING AND PLUMBING CODE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH AND REGULATING THE TYPE AND INSTALLATION OF SEA WALLS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY FLORIDA: THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH,

the Town adding to Section 1. Article No. 78 of the Electrical Code of Golden Beach be and the same is hereby amended lossed Article No. 78 the following:

"Number fourteen (14) wire shall be used for lighting circuits, only, and number twelve (12) wire to all convenience outlets.

All water heater equipment shall have number ten (#10) wire fused on both sides, and this also applies to all replacements".

Golden Beach be and the said Article No. 79 the 79 of the Building Code of the same is hereby amended by add-following:

Where a grounding conductor is connected to a water system, or driven ground of galvanized metal pipe, with well point, the ground connection shall be visible and accessible. This section must be fully complied with".

en Beach be and the same is Article 61 the following: hereby amended by add-

must be provided with a temperature relief value, located in the hot water line, where it leaves the tank, boiler or heater. Control values, drains and relief values must be placed so they are visible and accessible."

sec. 4. On the main waterway or Intracoastal canal and approaches, all sea walls shall be of the standard approved interlocking type made of concrete slabs at least 18 inches to 2 feet wide and 8 inches thick and said concrete slabs shall be jetted or driven to rock.

Sec. 5. All parts of the Building, Electrical and Plumbing Code in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
