

ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, REQUIRING THE CLEANING AND REMOVAL OF ALL DEBRIS IN FRONT OF ALL LOTS ON THE OCEAN FRONT, LEVYING A LOT CLEANING ASSESSMENT ON ALL OCEAN FRONT LOTS AND IMPOSING A LIEN ON SUCH LOTS AND REQUIRING THE TOWN MANAGER TO USE TOWN EQUIPMENT FOR SUCH WORK.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The owners or occupants of all lots in the Town of Golden Beach fronting on the Atlantic Ocean be and they are hereby required, after November 1st, 1950, to keep the ocean front part of said lots free from debris and trash.

Sec. 2. The Town Manager, be and he is hereby directed to use the Town bulldozer and other required Town equipment, after November 1st, 1950, in the continuous cleaning of all property directly on the ocean front or beach in the Town of Golden Beach so that the same may be free of debris and trash and so that the same shall not become a menace to the health or welfare of the occupants of ocean front property.

Sec. 3. There is hereby levied a tax or lien on each lot fronting on the Atlantic Ocean in the Town of Golden Beach of the sum of Twenty-five Dollars for the reasonable cost of said lot cleaning and said cost shall be included in the tax roll of the Town and collected with the annual real estate taxes assessed against said property.
