

ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, BY ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE ERECTION OF CABANAS AND OTHER STRUCTURES ON THE OCEAN BEACH AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. An emergency exists within the Town of Golden Beach, Florida, in the matter of the regulation of the construction of cabanas and other structures on the ocean beach, and this ordinance is therefore declared to be an emergency measure for the protection of the welfare and safety of the people of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida, and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.

Sec. 2. In order to protect persons and property from the ravages and damage by hurricanes and storms, no cabana or structure shall be permitted to be erected on the beach in front of any ocean front property or upon any ocean front property of a size which will contain more than 250 square feet of floor space and all such cabanas or structures must be located at least 75 feet from the mean high water, and, in no case, can said structure be built out further than a line which will conform to existing cabanas and no part of the roof of said cabanas or structures shall be higher than a line thirty (30) inches above the floor level of the present Loggia in the Town of Golden Beach, which floor level is hereby established as a base line.

Sec. 3. No permit for the erection of any cabana or structure which does not conform to Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be granted and the Building Inspector and other officials of the Town shall see to the enforcement of this Ordinance.

Sec. 4. Any person or persons, firm of corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$200.00, at the discretion of the Municipal Judge, and each day's violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.
