

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUILDING AND PLUMBING CODE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AND REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION OF SANITARY TOILETS BEFORE COMMENCING CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BUILDINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Building Code of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida, is hereby amended in that no construction of any buildings shall be commenced on any lot or property in the Town of Golden Beach until the builder or contractor shall have first installed a sanitary toilet or toilets for the use of such workmen, contractors or individuals who may be employed in the construction of such building.

Sec. 2. Immediately upon the installation of a septic tank on any new construction the sanitary toilet or toilets required to be installed shall be connected to said septic tanks.

Sec. 3. No open privies or toilets shall be permitted on any construction work in the Town of Golden Beach.

Sec. 4. The Building Inspector and the Town Police are hereby directed to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance and to arrest any offenders who shall be punished as provided in the Building Code of the Town for such violation.

Sec. 5. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to the health and public safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Golden Beach and shall become a law immediately upon its passage by the Town Council and approval by the Mayor.
