

ORDINANCE NO. 46

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH  
FLORIDA, AMENDING THE BUILDING AND PLUMB-  
ING CODE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH AND  
REQUIRING THE CONSTRUCTION OF GARAGES OR  
CAR-PORTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:


Section 1. The Building and Plumbing Code of the Town of Golden Beach is hereby amended to require that every house constructed hereafter in the Town of Golden Beach shall be provided with at least one garage or car-port and properly screened on the side street. The design of said screen shall conform architecturally to the structure of the house and neighboring structures and the erection of the same shall require a building permit and the plans and specifications therefor shall be submitted to the Building Inspector for approval.

Sec. 2. In Blocks "A", "B", "C" and "D" no garage or car-port shall be built on any lot except on the westerly end thereof and all garages and car-ports shall be of fireproof type construction.

Sec. 3. All parts of the Building or Plumbing Code in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.


Sec. 4. This Ordinance shall be declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Golden Beach and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Town Council.
