

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH
AMENDING THE SANITARY CODE OF THE TOWN
AND REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION OF WASTE
RECEPTACLES AND GARBAGE CONTAINERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. All sanitary Ordinances of the Town of Golden Beach are hereby amended so that it shall be required that all homes already constructed and all dwellings which may hereafter be constructed within the limits of the Town of Golden Beach be provided with an adequate number of waste receptacles of either above ground type "Garb-Bin" or "Sani-Garb" or equal, or shall be equipped with underground type of ~~garbage~~ receptacles with aluminum step-on lid or such step-on lid which will be of equal quality.

Sec. 2. All parts of the Sanitary Code of the Town of Golden Beach in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall be declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the health, welfare and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Golden Beach and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Town Council.
