

ORDINANCE NO. 48

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUILDING CODE
OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH AND REGULATING
THE CONSTRUCTION OF BOAT HOUSES
AND CABANAS ON THE WATERWAYS OF THE TOWN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:


Section 1. No boathouse or cabana shall be erected or built on the waterways of the Town of Golden Beach which shall exceed eight feet above mean tide in height, nor shall any of the boathouses or cabanas exceed one hundred square feet in area and all boathouses and cabanas shall be constructed of solid masonry and shall be finished either in concrete block, stucco or brick. No boathouse or cabana shall be attached to the main residence.

Sec. 2. Boathouses or cabanas may be built to the lot line and a set-back shall not be required.


Sec. 3. All parts of the Building Code in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This Ordinance shall be declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the safety and health of the inhabitants of the Town of Golden Beach and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Town Council.
