

ORDINANCE # 5.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, NAMING INSPECTORS AND CLERK FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE THIRD TUESDAY IN FEBRUARY, A. D. 1933.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA,

SECTION 1. That the following qualified voters of the Town of Golden Beach be and they are hereby named inspectors of the general election to be held in said town on the third Tuesday in February, A. D. 1933, to-wit:

Wilder W. Mentzer Inspector

Manola W. Lane Inspector

Almeda VanderWeals Inspector

SECTION 2. It is further ordained that Messie M. Fiedler a qualified voter of the Town of Golden Beach, be and she is hereby named Clerk of the General Election to be held in said town on the third Tuesday in February, A. D. 1933.

SECTION 3. That said inspectors and clerk shall have all the powers provided for in Section 5 of Ordinance No. 3 of the Town of Golden Beach, and shall hold the election provided for in Ordinance No. 3, in accordance with the provisions of said ordinance.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
