

ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA PROHIBITING OVERNIGHT PARKING ON THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:


Section 1. That the parking of automobiles and other motor vehicles upon the streets and highways of the Town of Golden Beach between the hours of 1:00 A. M., and 6:00 A. M., be and the same is hereby prohibited.

Sec. 2. It is the intention of this Ordinance to prohibit so-called overnight parking on the streets and avenues of the Town of Golden Beach.

Sec. 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$25.00 or to imprisonment for not more than five (5) days, in the discretion of the Municipal Judge.

Sec. 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to the safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Golden Beach and shall become a law immediately upon its passage by the Town Council and approval by the Mayor.






