AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, CLASSIFYING, REGULATING AND/OR PROHIBITING CERTAIN NOISES IN SAID TOWN AND FIXING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 3: RESTRIC restrictions: RESTRICTED NOISES: shall grouped Other noises, I uped as follows because of their nature s for the purpose of con control

Group "A" Steam, gasoline or oil operated cranes, pile-drivers, excavators, dredges, ditchers and all other similar machinery; one cylinder steam or internal combustion engines (horizontal or vertical); air compressors and pneumatic riveting machines, jackhammers, drills and other similar air equipment; power band and circular saws working in the open; hand hammers on steel or iron (structural, rivets or otherwise) and all other noises of similar intensity and/or annoyance.

Group "B" Stationary or portable concrete mixers (engines multi-cylindered and properly muffled); power band and circular saws, sanders, planers, grinding machines, drills, barbenders and cutters and similar machinery when enclosed; hand operations in connection with plumbing, electrical, roofing and framing work in the open.

Group "C" Transit concrete mixers (engined multi-cylindered and properly muffled) operated to cause the least possible noise; hand operations in connection with plumbing, electrical, roofing and framing work when enclosed; hand loading and unloading and the hauling of building materials and other similar heavy trucking; masonry work and the hand mixing of mortar; plastering and the hand mixing of plaster; painting; glazing; landscaping and all other noises of similar intensity and/or annoyance.

SECTION 4: PERIODS: the year shall be di RIODS: For the purpose of controlling be divided into two periods as follows: For "Restricted Noises"

SECTION 5: The "Restricted Noises" set forth in Section 3 of this ordinare hereby prohibited at any location and at any hour on Sundays and the hours on week days during which said "Restricted Noises" of the various classifications, regardless of location, are hereby prohibited are as follows:

SECTION 6: The "Restricted Noises" included in Groups "A" and "B", as set forth in Section 3 of this ordinance are hereby prohibited within 150 yards of the nearest point of any building occupied as a Residence, at all hours during the period of time referred to and described in Section 4 of this ordinance as Period No.

SECTION 7: EXCEPTIONS:

- 1. The requirements of this Ordinance shall not be construed to prevent the operation of automobiles or light delivery vehicles at any time; provided, however, that such motor vehicles shall at all times be properly muffled and shall be so operated as to create the least possible noise or nuisance.
- 2. The Town Manager shall have the right to waive any requirements herein in cases of emergency where the welfare opposity may be jeopardized by their strict enforcement. y or all of the of persons or

SECTION 8: PENALTIES:

Violators of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable upon conviction, by a fine of not more than \$150.00 or imprisonment of not more than 10 days or by both. Each separate violation shall be considered as a separate offense and may be punishable as such.

SECTION 9: LEGALITY:

If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in effect as if the unconstitutional portion or portions have
