

ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC IN THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. No vehicle shall be driven or operated, or caused to be driven or operated upon Ocean Boulevard in the Town of Golden Beach at a higher rate of speed than thirty (30) miles per hour and no vehicle shall be driven or operated, or caused to be driven or operated on any other of the streets or Avenues of the Town of Golden Beach at a higher rate of speed than twenty (20) miles per hour.

Sec. 2. The Town Manager be and he is hereby authorized to designate certain streets in the Town of Golden Beach as "through" streets and to mark streets or avenues intersecting such "through" streets with "stop" signs.

Sec. 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any vehicle across any street which is designated as a "through" street at which intersections have been placed "stop" signs by the Town, without first coming to a full stop.

Sec. 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$5.00, nor more than \$200.00 and imprisonment in the Town jail for not more than ten (10) days, at the discretion of the Municipal Judge.

Sec. 5. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the protection of the public safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Golden Beach and shall become a law immediately upon its passage by the Town Council and approval by the Mayor.
