

ORDINANCE NO. 57

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 41 WHICH  
REQUIRED THE CLEANING AND REMOVAL OF ALL DEBRIS  
IN FRONT OF ALL LOTS ON THE OCEAN FRONT, LEVY-  
ING A LOT CLEANING ASSESSMENT ON ALL OCEAN FRONT  
LOTS AND IMPOSING A LIEN ON SUCH LOTS AND RE-  
QUIRING THE TOWN MANAGER TO USE TOWN EQUIPMENT  
FOR SUCH WORK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF  
GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 41 approved the 2nd  
day of May, 1950, requiring the cleaning and removal of  
all debris in front of all lots on the ocean front, levy-  
ing a lot cleaning assessment on all ocean front lots and  
imposing a lien on such lots and requiring the Town  
Manager to use town equipment for such work, be and the  
same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall become effective  
November 1, 1953, and no assessments will therea/ter be  
levied; provided, however, all assessments hereto/ore  
levied and unpaid be and the same are hereby ratified  
and confirmed.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emer-  
gency measure.
