

ORDINANCE NO. 63

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH; REGULATING THE SPEED OF OPERATION OF AUTOMOBILES WITHIN THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH; DECLARING IT UNLAWFUL TO COMMIT CERTAIN ACTS OR DO CERTAIN THINGS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH; DECLARING IT UNLAWFUL TO DESTROY ANY PUBLIC PROPERTY; REGULATING THE DUMPING OF TRASH AND GARBAGE ON THE HIGHWAYS OF THE TOWN AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. No vehicle shall be driven or operated or caused to be driven or operated upon Ocean Boulevard, in the Town of Golden Beach at a higher rate of speed than thirty (30) miles per hour and no vehicle shall be driven or operated, or caused to be driven or operated on any other of the streets or avenues of the Town of Golden Beach at a higher rate of speed than twenty (20) miles per hour.

Sec. 2. The Town Manager be and he is hereby authorized to designate certain streets in the Town of Golden Beach as "through" streets and to mark streets or avenues intersecting such "through" streets with "stop" signs.

Sec. 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any vehicle across any street which is designated as a "through" street at which intersections have been placed "stop" signs by the Town, without first coming to a full stop.

Sec. 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to be found in a state of intoxication in any public place in the Town of Golden Beach, Florida.

Sec. 5. It shall be unlawful for any person to be found in a state of nudity or in a dress not becoming to his or her sex, or to make any indecent exposure of his or her person, or be guilty of any indecent or lewd behavior, or exhibit, sell or offer to sell any indecent or lewd book, picture or other thing, or exhibit or perform any indecent, immoral or lewd play or other presentation in any public place in the Town of Golden Beach, Florida.

Sec. 6. It shall be unlawful for any person to bathe, wash or swim in any river, canal, pool, bay or ocean within the corporate limits of the Town of Golden Beach, being naked or insufficiently clothed to present improper exposure of his or her person.

Sec. 7. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep a bawdy house of prostitution in the Town of Golden Beach, Florida.

Sec. 8. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any automobile or other vehicle in a disorderly and dangerous manner through the streets, or who shall ride on or place an automobile, wagon, cart or vehicle on the sidewalk or stop such vehicle on a regular street crossing, except in loading and unloading such vehicles or drive an automobile or self-propelled vehicle and leave their motors running without an attendant, in the Town of Golden Beach, Florida.

Sec. 9. It shall be unlawful for any person to desecrate or despoil any public building or property set apart for public use or held for benevolent or charitable purposes or in any way destroy any shrubbery planted within the limits of the Town of Golden Beach or drive or cause to be driven any vehicle over any of the park or parkways of the Town of Golden Beach or in any way damage or post bills upon any private property or destroy any plants, shrubs, flowers or trees growing upon private property without the permission of the owner thereof.

Sec. 10. It shall be unlawful for any person to resist arrest by any officer of the Town of Golden Beach, or resist any person called upon by an officer to aid him in making an arrest.

Sec. 11. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive an automobile within the corporate limits of the Town of Golden Beach while in a drunken or intoxicated condition or drive an automobile or motor vehicle in a reckless manner over or upon any sidewalk, boardwalk or concrete walk, in the corporate limits or drive at a rate of speed greater than ~~the corporate limits~~ <sup>thirty</sup> ~~thirty~~ <sup>thirty</sup> miles an hour or turn corners or approach other automobiles, motorcycles, or pedestrians in a reckless manner, or drive with mufflers open in the Town of Golden Beach, Florida.

Sec. 12. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to dump cans, boxes or garbage of any description in the highways, waterways, or on any public or private property in the Town of Golden Beach without first obtaining the permission of the Town Police.

Sec. 13. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or failing, neglecting or refusing to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or in any manner interfering with, hindering or preventing any officer or person herein mentioned, in the performance of any duty required by the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction in the municipal court, be liable to a fine of not ~~more~~ <sup>less</sup> than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), or to be imprisoned in the Town jail for not exceeding ten (10) days, or both such fine and imprisonment for each and every offense, at the discretion of the Municipal Judge.

Sec. 14. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Sec. 15. This Ordinance shall be declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the protection and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Golden Beach, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Town Council.
