

ORDINANCE NO. 8.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, FOR PROTECTION OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, AND TO PROTECT THE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM OF SAID TOWN AND PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. An emergency exists within the Town of Golden Beach in the matter of the unauthorized use of water and interference with the water supply system of the Town of Golden Beach, and this ordinance is therefore declared to be an emergency measure for the protection of the property and welfare of the people of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida, and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.

Sec. 2. Whoever shall tap into the water main system of the Town of Golden Beach, or take or use water from said mains or any of the hydrants, faucets or stop cocks of the water works system of the Town of Golden Beach, without having the right to do so by reason of a permit with the Mayor or Town Clerk, or without having received permission from the Town Council, or who shall without permission of the Mayor or Town Clerk, open any fire plug, hydrant, stop cock or valve or tap into the water main of the town, or open any other fix-
