

RESOLUTION NO. 881.94 OF THE
TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
GOLDEN BEACH OPPOSING FLORIDA
STATE HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTIONS
(HJR) 147 REGARDING LIMITING
THE AMOUNT OF THE HOMESTEAD
EXEMPTION.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach has reviewed proposed Constitutional Amendment to the Homestead Exemption, (House Joint Resolution 147, Senate Bill 482), and

WHEREAS, said proposal would substantially revise the Homestead Exemption, and

WHEREAS, the average home in Golden Beach is valued in excess of \$255,000, and

WHEREAS, approximately 80% of the property owners in the Town of Golden Beach would lose their Homestead Exemption.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. That the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach feels this proposed legislation is unfair.

Section 2. That the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach urges the State Legislature to reject this proposed amendment.
