RESOLUTION NO. 890.94**

RESOLUTION NO. 890.94 OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE TOWN MANAGER TO TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION TO ENFORCE THE PARKING AREA AT TWEDDLE PARK AS A MUNICIPAL PARKING AREA FOR USE BY RESIDENTS AND VISITORS; PROVIDING FOR PARKING PERMITS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT BY CITATION AND TOWING; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 9.05 of the Town Code authorizes the Town Council to

designate "areas of the town as municipal and/or public parking areas;" and

WHEREAS, Section 9.05 of the Town Code designated the parking facilities at the tennis courts now known as Tweddle Park as a municipal parking area, and

WHEREAS, Section 9.05 of the Town Code provides for the posting of tow away signs in conformance with Florida Statutes and the enforcement of the municipal parking area,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the preambles recited above are true and correct and are hereby adopted.

Section 2. That the Town Manager is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution, pursuant to Section 9.05 of the Town Code, establishing the parking spaces adjacent to, and provided for Tweddle Park as a Municipal Parking Area as more particularly provided below:

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A. Parking shall be restricted to motor vehicles which have affixed to the lower left front windshield a validly issued town parking permit.

B. Parking during the times of 5:30 p.m through 6:00 a.m weekdays and all day Saturday, Sunday and legal holidays when town hall is closed, shall be restricted to those vehicles that have and display a validly issued town parking permit.

C. Tow Away Zone Signs which comply with Section 715.07, Florida Statutes shall be displayed at the Municipal Parking Area before any towing is authorized.

D. No motor vehicle shall be parked in a Municipal Parking Area unless it has a valid parking permit properly displayed. The owners of motor vehicles improperly parked in this area shall be in violation of the Town Code and subject to a Metropolitan Dade County Uniform Parking Complaint and Ticket, resulting in a penalty as provided in the Metropolitan Dade County Code, Section 30-388.25 (b), as may be amended from time to time. Such motor vehicles, parked without a valid permit may be towed upon the direction of a town police officer at the motor vehicle owner's expense, to be impounded by the

towing company pending payment of towing and storage charges.

E. Parking Permits shall be issued by the Town Manager or his designee to any town resident who provides proof of residency and a vehicle registration for the vehicle owned or controlled by the resident to which the parking permit is issued. Permits are not transferrable to other owners or other motor vehicles.

F. Residents may obtain additional parking permits for additional motor vehicles by presenting the registration for the additional motor vehicle as provided in subsection 2. E above, to the City Manager or his designee.

G. Non residents may purchase Parking Permits which shall be issued by the Town Manager or his designee to any non resident who provides proof of address and a vehicle registration for the vehicle owned or controlled by the non resident to which the parking permit is issued, and payment of the fee provided in

Section 3, below.

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Section 3. That a parking permit shall be issued for the charges provided in section 9.05 of the town code, which are:

\$50.00 (per motor vehicle) every 2 years for residents.

\$1,000.00 (per motor vehicle) every year for non residents.

Resident fees are to be deducted from ad valorem taxes. Non resident fees shall be paid by the applicant at the time the permit is issued.

Section 4. That parking permits shall expire on September 30, 1996 and each succeeding September 30th in even numbered years thereafter. Resident parking permits issued in odd numbered years shall be at one half the above stated charge. Non resident parking permits obtained after March 31st shall be at one half the abovestated charge.

Section 5. That all revenues collected for parking permits shall be budgeted for Tweddle Park and parking area maintenance, repair, renewal and replacement expenses, and reimbursements of Tweddle Park grant funds, upon further direction of the Town Council.

Section 6. Repealer That all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of conflict.

Section 7. Severability That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of

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the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Resolution shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 8. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.

The Motion to adopt the foregoing Resolution was offered by COUNCILMAN DUFFNER, seconded by COUNCILMAN ADDICOTT and on roll call the following vote ensued:
