RESOLUTION NO. 891.94 OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, PROVIDING PROCEDURES, INCLUDING REGISTRATION AND RESERVATIONS, FOR USE OF THE FACILITIES AT TWEDDLE PARK, PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 9.06 of the Town Code authorizes the Town Council by

resolution to adopt rules governing the use of the parks and recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to establish a registration and reservation procedure for the use of the facilities at Tweddle Park.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the preambles recited above are true and correct and are hereby adopted.

Section 2. That individuals desiring to use the facilities at Tweddle Park, including the basketball court and tennis courts, recreation pavillion and tot lot, shall first register at the Administration Department giving their name and address and number of people in their party. Reservations shall be accepted up to forty-eight (48) hours in advance of the time requested. Reserved time shall be limited to one hour if other individuals are requesting a subsequent reservation. Groups of ten or more individuals shall reserve the facilities at least seven (7) days prior to such use. For purposes of Town Code Section 9.06 (H) 3, this Section shall be considered a "Rule".

Section 3. That in all other respects the provisions of Town Code Section 9.06 shall be enforced.

Section 4. Repealer. That all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of conflict.

Section 5. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Resolution shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 6. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.


