

RESOLUTION NO. 907.94

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH ADOPTING THE FINAL BUDGET OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 1994 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1995 PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTES SECTION 200.065 (TRIM BILL); AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN CLERK TO FORWARD COPIES OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE APPROPRIATE GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
