RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN
BEACH ACCEPTING THE RESULTS OF THE
SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON SEPTEMBER
8, 1994

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach held a Special Election on Thursday, September 8, 1994, for the purpose of asking the question "Shall the Golden Beach Town Charter be amended to add a requirement that annexation of real property (which is the increase of the land area of Golden Beach) would only be permitted by the approval of a majority of the town voters voting in a town wide referendum?"
